

PRESENTERS

Rev. Dr. Richard Stuckwisch has served Emmaus Lutheran Church in South Bend since he was ordained in May 1996. He has Ph.D. in liturgical studies from the University of Notre Dame, and a S.T.M. in historical theology from Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne. He served on the Lectionary Committee and the Lord's Supper working group of the Lutheran Hymnal Project from the beginning of that work in 1998 until the introduction of the Lutheran Service Book in 2006. He is currently working on a book, based on his dissertation research, tracing the history of service books and hymnals in the LCMS. He is also overseeing and coordinating the Gerhardt Hymn Project, with a view toward making the hymns of Paul Gerhardt available and accessible in English translation for the use of the Church. Pastor Stuckwisch and his wife, LaRena, have 10 children and recently celebrated the birth of their first grandchild, Sarena Frances Wirgau.

Rev. Dr. Paul Grime is dean of the chapel and associate professor at Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, teaching primarily in the area of worship. From 1996-2007 he served as executive director for the LCMS Commission on Worship in St. Louis.. In that position he was project director for both the *Hymnal Supplement 98* and *Lutheran Service Book*. Prior to that he served eight years as senior pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, West Allis, Wisconsin.

Grime is a graduate of Archbold High School. He has music degrees from Valparaiso University (B.Mus.) and the College-Conservatory of Music, University of Cincinnati (M.Music). His theology degrees are from Concordia Theological Seminary (M.Div., S.T.M.) and Marquette University (Ph.D.).

Grime is married to Debra, and together they have two sons.

Rev. Richard Heinz is senior pastor of Saint John's Ev. Lutheran Church & School in Lanesville, IN, where he has served for ten years. Pastor Heinz is a graduate of Concordia University – River Forest (1991) and Concordia Seminary, St. Louis (1995).

Pastor Heinz's family began in Chicago, where he served as pastor of Mount Greenwood Lutheran Church from 1995-99. In 1997 he married Kristi (nee Wernsman) and in 1998, God gave a son, Benjamin. A student of the liturgy, Pastor Heinz enjoys learning all he can about the Divine Service and Prayer Offices.

Kantor Kevin Hildebrand serves as Associate Kantor at Concordia Theological Seminary, Ft. Wayne, IN. There he teaches vocal development, music fundamentals, and worship. Wayne and has served as Pastor of congregations in Saskatchewan (LCC), and most recently in Greenfield, IN. He was a member of the Committee on Worship and Spiritual Care from 1997-2006.

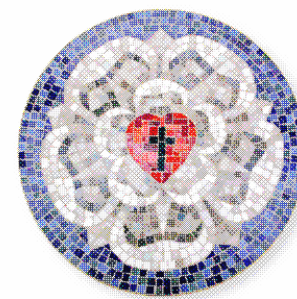

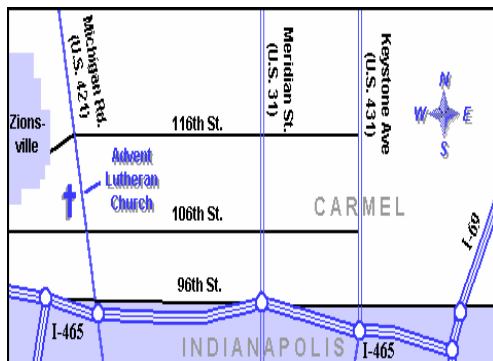
